

FAA Eligibility Requirements for Inspection Authorization (IA)

Applicants must meet FAR Part 65.91, which includes:

- Holding a current A&P rating for 3 years, and being engaged in maintaining aircraft for 2 years prior to the date of application.
- Having a fixed base of operation.
- Having the equipment, facilities, and inspection data available to properly perform I.A. duties.

Inspection Authorization Course

- Our I.A. course has been developed from the latest FAA data. We feel that it is the best on the market at this time.
- It is designed to make you proficient in the use of Type Certificate Data Sheets, FAA Regulations, Airworthiness Directives and Advisory Circulars.
- Your instructor will answer any questions that you may have.
- You must get permission to test from your own FSDO in your geographical region.
- Once issued the FAA form 8610-1, the applicant may test at any testing center authorized to give the I.A. examination.
- Schedule your examination as soon as possible after the completion of the course. The average length of the I.A. course is five days, which will, of course, depend on the individual.
